School Council Members Visit to London

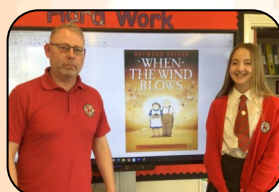

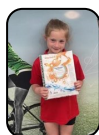
