If your child would like to buy a cake, please send them to school with change (cakes will be 20p or 50p) on their allocated day.

Eggs-ellent Design The School Council will be holding their Design an Egg competition (no cost). Design sheets will be sent home with all pupils on Monday 31st March and entries must be returned by Monday 7th April.

Bonnet and Egg Parade Pupils are invited to decorate a bonnet or egg for our Easter competition. If your child would like to take part, they need to bring in their decorated Easter Bonnet or Egg on Wednesday 9th April for judging. Everyone who participates will receive a certificate and small prize. Remember - it doesn't need to be perfect and the more involvement pupils have, the better!
