The 5 ways to wellbeing

This week our focus is **GIVE**. Giving isn't just about presents or money – it's about kindness, time, and helping others. When children give, they feel more connected, confident, and happy. Research shows that even small acts of giving can boost wellbeing for both the giver and the receiver.

In school, giving can look like sharing resources, helping another child in class, including others in games, or saying something kind. At home, it might be setting the table, helping a sibling, making a card for someone, or donating toys they no longer use.

We encourage families to talk about giving together:

- How does it feel to help someone?
- What's one small kind thing we can do today?
- Who in our community might need a little extra support?

By practising giving, children learn empathy, gratitude, and the joy of making a positive difference. Little actions really do add up – and kindness is something we can all afford to share.
