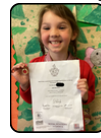


Miss Gregory’s Class - 100%!

Well done to Beatrix who has been graded at Karate and recieved her Orange belt on Sunday. Fantastic Beatrix!

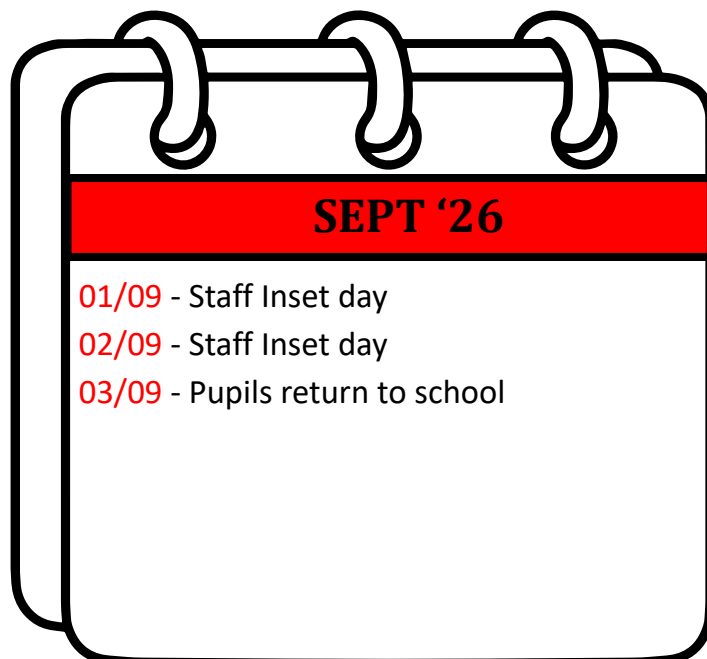
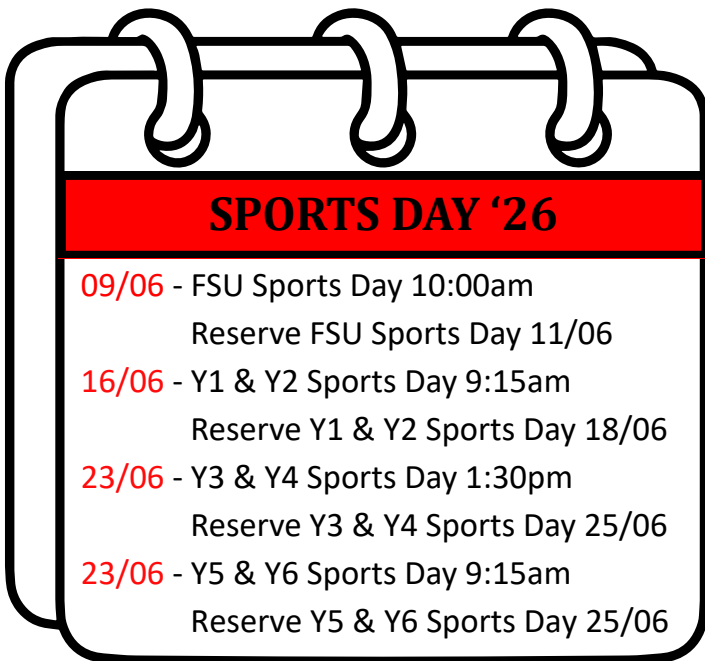
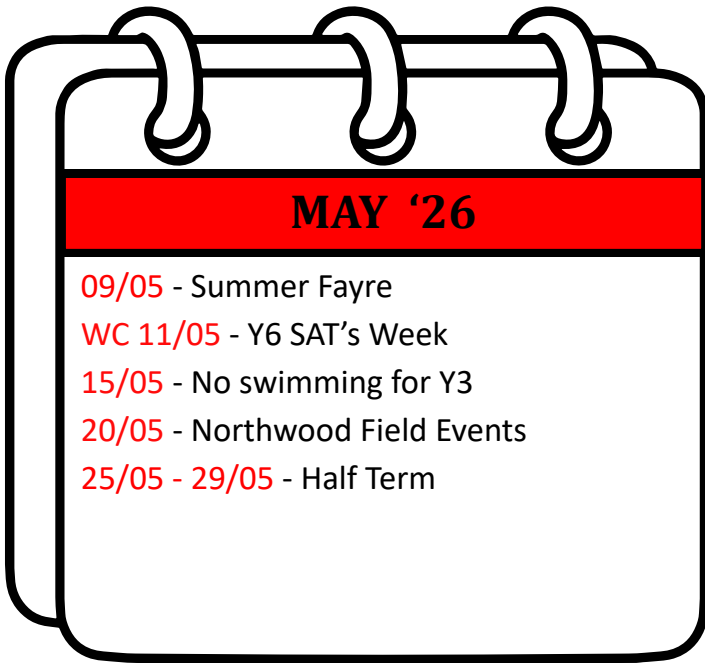
