Congratulations to Oscar who received this special medal from football last week. He brilliantly demonstrated the skills he has been learning. Well done Oscar!



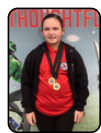
Congratulations Maya on your super swimming this week!

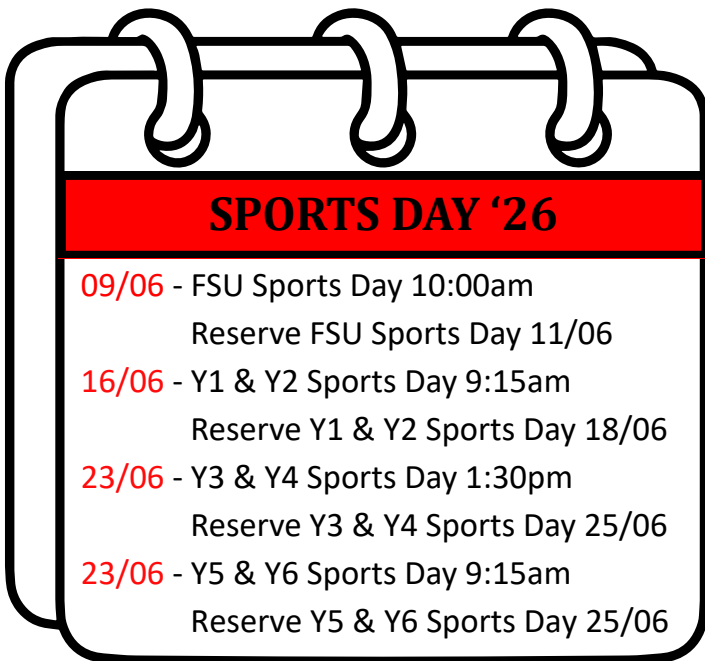
